

RoHS 3 COMPLIANCE STATEMENT

RoHS 3 (EU 2015/863)

Following a review of the list of restricted substances under the Restriction on the use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive [RoHS], the European Commission has now published Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863. This legislation provides an amendment to Annex II of RoHS (2011/65/EU) and confirms the inclusion of four new restricted substances.

The additional substance restrictions and maximum concentration values (outlined below) came into force as from 22 July 2019:

- bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)
